# Resort Guidelines

- Speed limit:** 5 mph within the resort. Please watch for children.
- Checkout time:** 12 noon for campsites. 11 am for motel. If you would like a late checkout (6 pm), you must make arrangements prior to 12 noon at the registration booth.
- Registration:** state law requires all campers to register before occupying any space. Please do not change your assigned space without the approval of the office.
- Visitors:** maximum of 6 persons permitted on any site at one time. All visitors must be registered at gate & will be charged for your entire length of stay. Visitors who turn in their car pass before 12 noon will be entitled to a refund for any additional days. Visitors will not be allowed to arrive after 10 pm, unless prior arrangements have been made at registration. We will refuse visitors to any site with 6 or more persons.
- Clotheslines:** please do not attach clotheslines to any trees, poles or fences.
- Marina:** dockage fee must be paid before launching boat.

- Waste water:** must be disposed of properly—not dumped on the ground. Detergent water will kill trees & plants. Please help us protect them.
  - Motorcycles:** city regulations forbid registered guests from pleasure riding of motorcycles or motorscooters within or near the resort.
  - State/County laws:** no ground or open fires permitted (grills only). No open alcoholic beverages inside store.
  - Pets:** must be tied or leashed at all times. Owners are required to clean up after pets. Pets are not allowed on beaches, pool area or motel units. Please keep pets quiet and never left unattended. Please never leave your pet in a locked, closed car.

## MILE MARKERS

Getting to know your way around the Keys begins with understanding the unique way distances are designated on the Florida Keys Overseas Highway. The highway is dotted with green-and-white signs called mile markers (MM), often referred to as mile posts, beginning with Mile Marker 126, just south of Florida City and ending with Mile Marker Zero at the corner of Fleming and Whitehead streets in Key West.

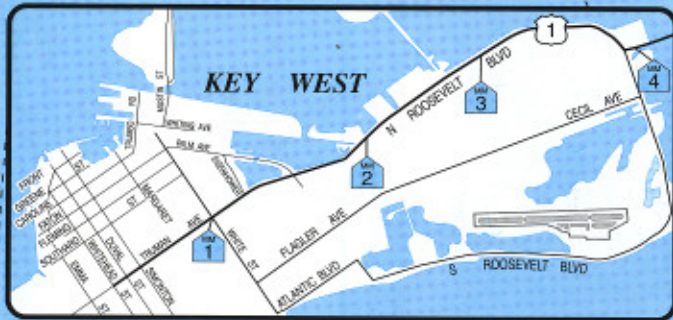
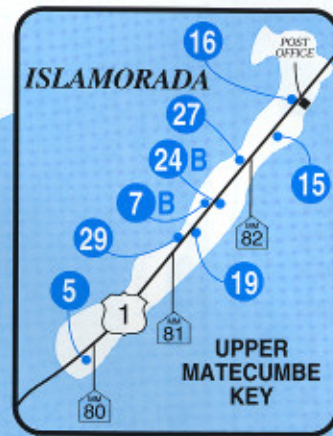
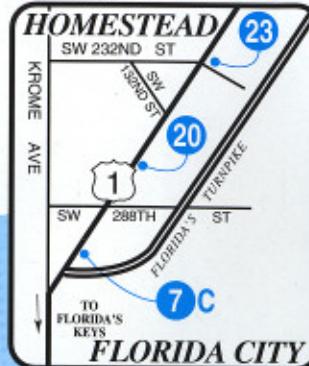
Awareness of these markers is useful as Keys' residents use them continually. When asking for directions in the Keys, your answer will likely be at, just before or just beyond a mile marker number.

Don't despair if you make a wrong turn; after all, none of the Keys' islands are more than a few miles wide so you won't have much trouble finding the highway again.

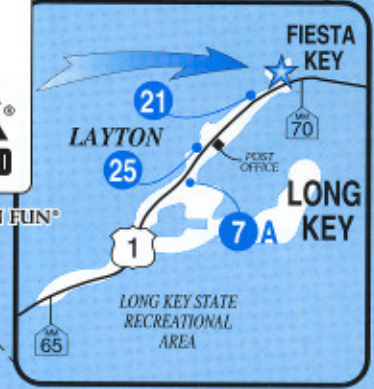
MILE MARKERS HERE ARE INDICATED BY:
