## MASS NOTIFICATION SYSTEM FOR TGO

Mass Notification has nothing to do with letting parishioners know when the services start, but everything to do about keeping residents at The Great Outdoors informed on issues regarding safety and emergencies.

Systems for Mass Notification began development after the 1996 Khobar Towers bombing in Saudi Arabia. Subsequent tragedies have made it all too apparent that during a crisis, people need to know when to stay put, when to leave, and where to go for safety. The latest systems are designed to deliver rapid, consistent information to anyone, anywhere, anytime and on any possible communications device in use today.

After getting demonstrations from various providers, the EADS North America PLANT CML system was selected as being the best for our community. The Board of Directors approved it on April 21 and it should be operational in about a month.

This system's flexibility allows TGO management to notify all residents who have submitted their contact information, about emergencies such as fire, severe weather, evacuation, water main breaks, and more. It can also be used to poll residents about issues affecting TGO. When renters register, entering their contact information will allow them to be notified of emergencies during their stay.

In order to be included on the notification list, residents need to submit their contact information to the CSA Office. If you haven't updated your information lately use the form that's with the Manager's Corner on Page 3. Notification will be sent repeatedly to each resident's entire set of contact numbers and addresses until that resident confirms receipt of the message on any one of the contact points.
