



For Passengers Riding *The Silverton* Train

1. If you have small children, please see that they obey the safety regulations and that they do not run or play in the aisles. Please do not leave children unattended. Passengers are prohibited from leaning from cars.



2. Be aware that airborne cinders are prevalent. Passengers are encouraged to wear some form of eye protection. In case of a cinder associated problem, please see the train personnel. Safety glasses are available for purchase in our gift shop or on board.



3. Please look at your tickets: they show you the date, car you are to ride in and seats you are to occupy. Please go directly to your train. Your "Seat No." is located above the windows; even numbers are the window seat, odd numbers are on the aisle. Please be on time! You must be seated by time specified on your tickets.



4. There are restrooms in all of the closed coaches and trash receptacles in all cars. Bottled water is available for purchase in the concession car.



5. Passengers are not allowed to stand or ride on the platforms of the coaches when the train is in motion.



6. When the train stops enroute, do not get off the train.



7. The open gondola cars on the train are reserved also. You must be ticketed for those cars in order to ride in them. Please do not block aisles.



8. There is a concession car on the train. Snacks, beverages, film, and souvenirs are available. It is not open until the conductor has collected your tickets.



9. Smoking is not allowed aboard the trains.



10. Delays: While every effort is made to maintain our train and bus schedules, mechanical and weather condition delays may arise. The Durango and Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad will not be held liable for any delays whatever the cause.
